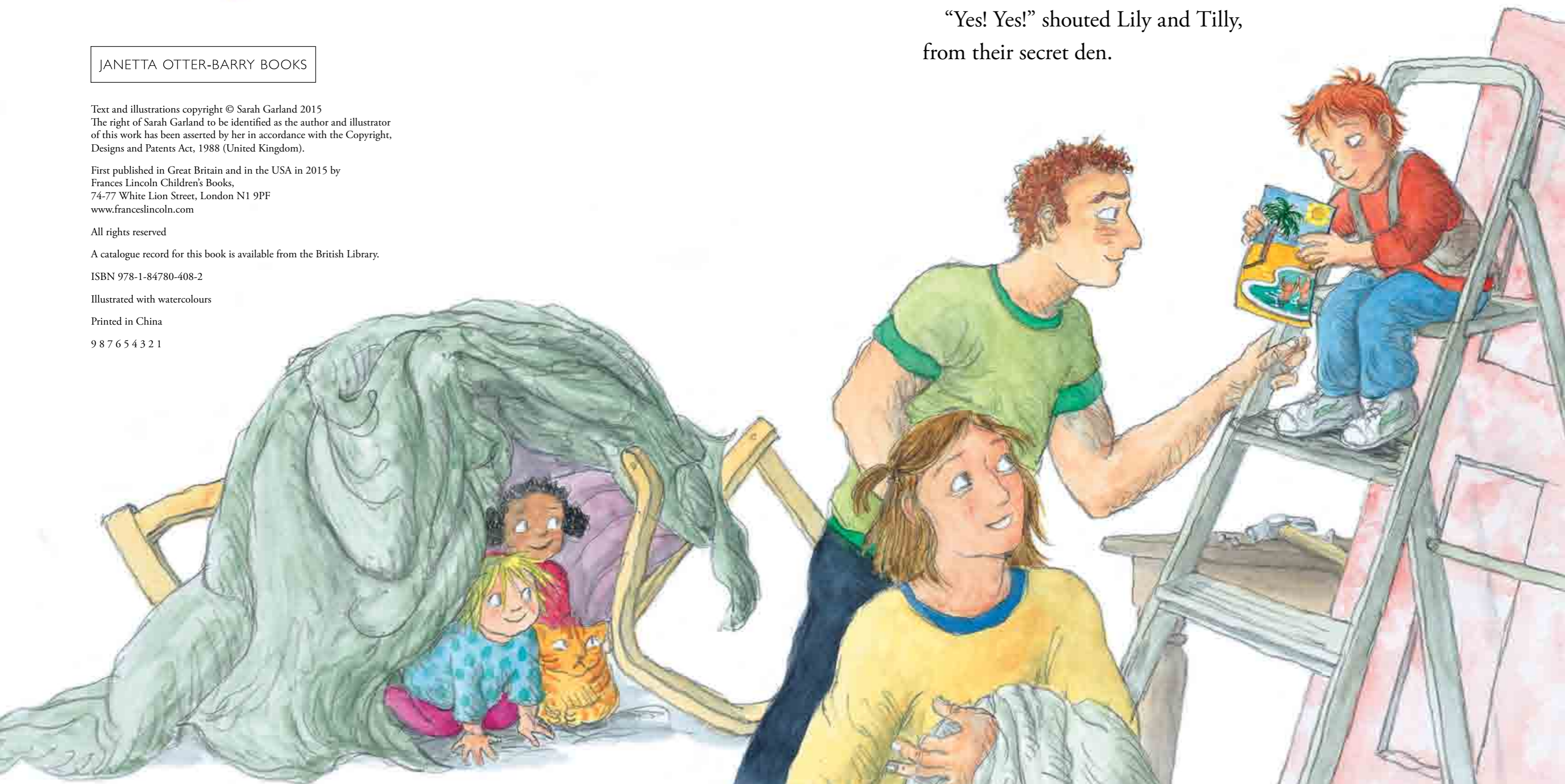
Eddie, Tom and Mum were thinking about a holiday.

asked Eddie.

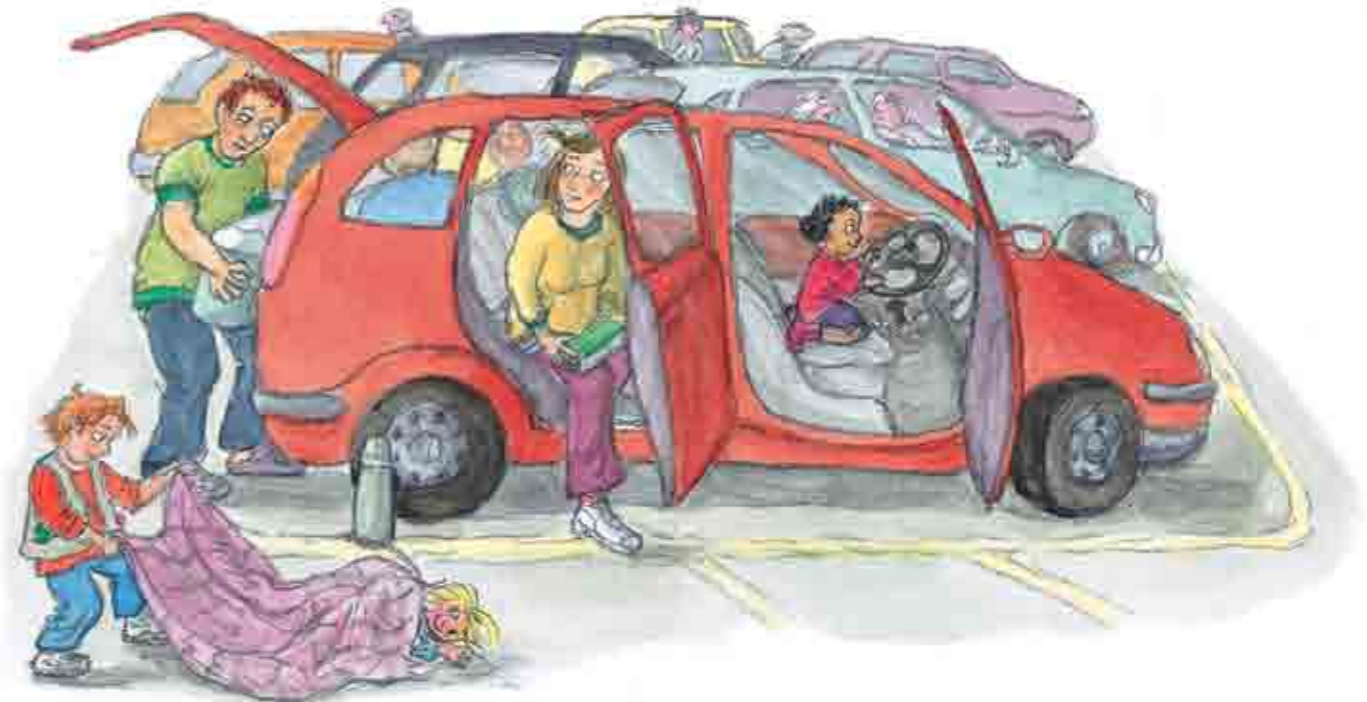
“He can stay with Angie down
