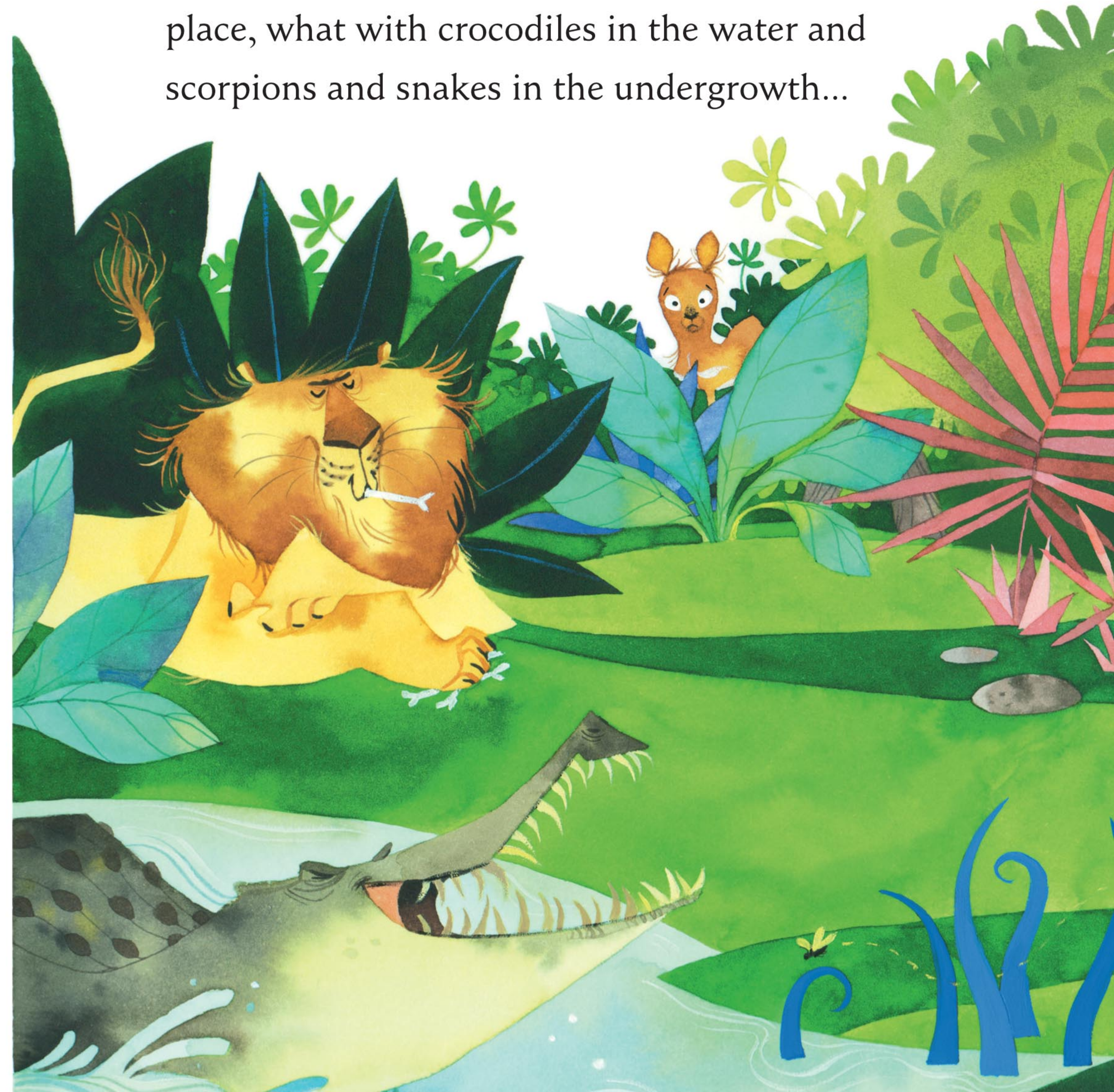


# THE KING'S PUDDING
