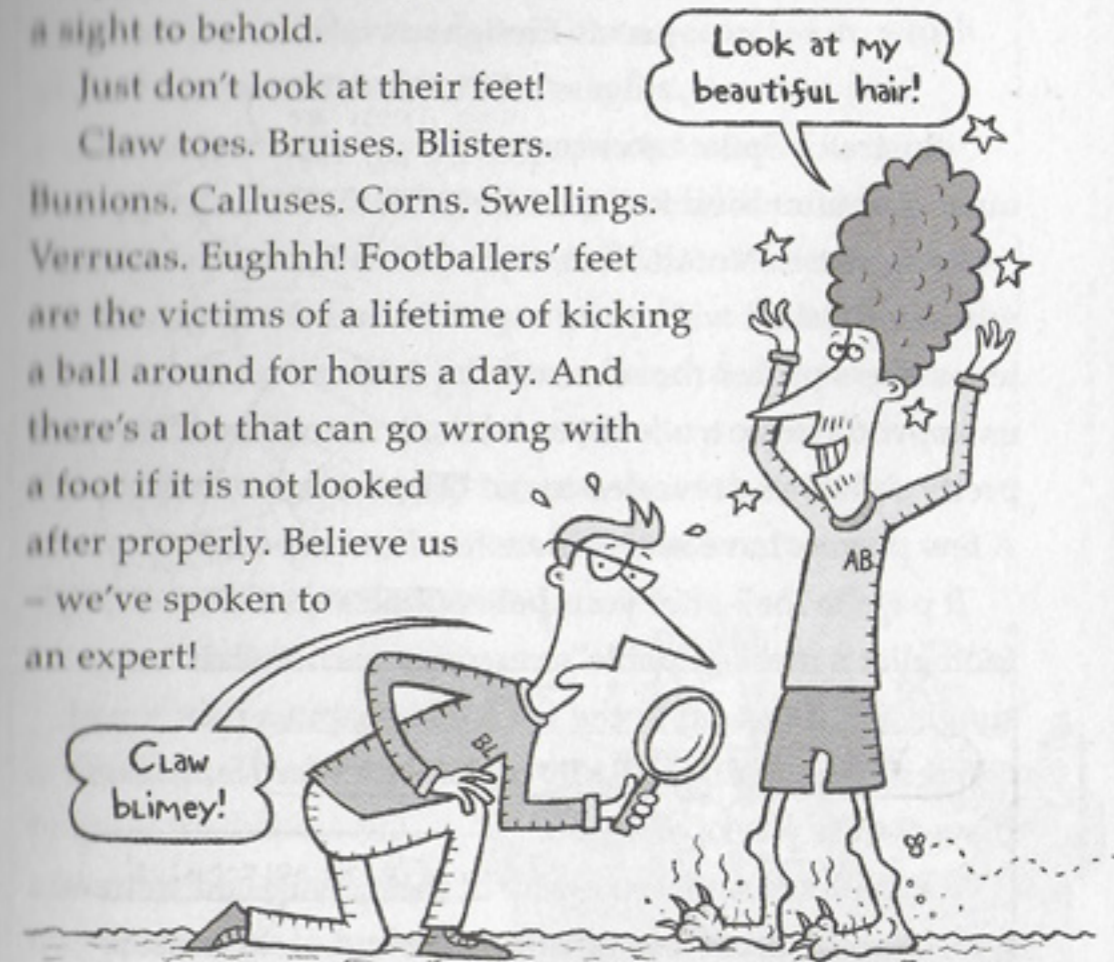


BIOLOGY
