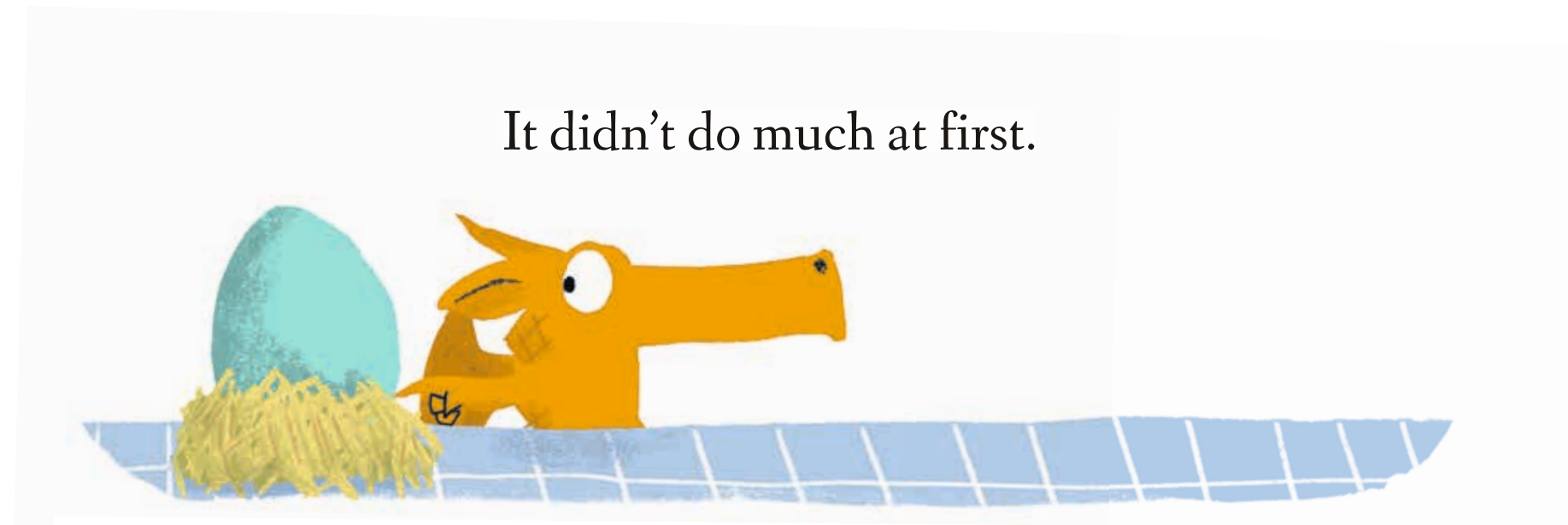
And this is Fergal

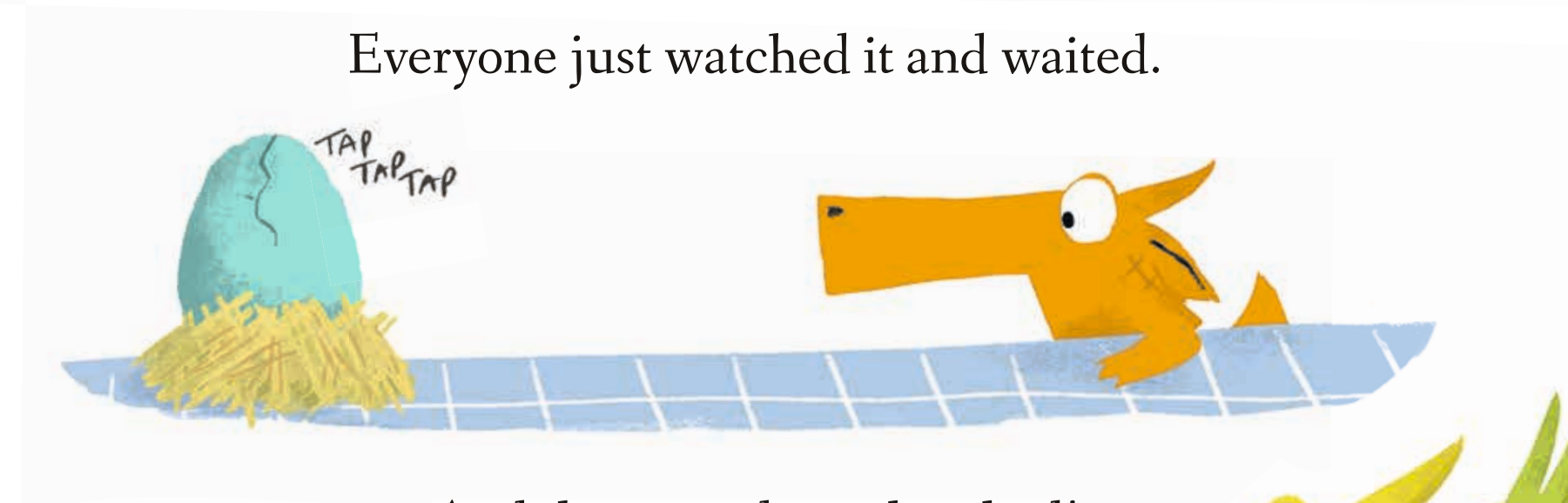
He's a happy little chap.



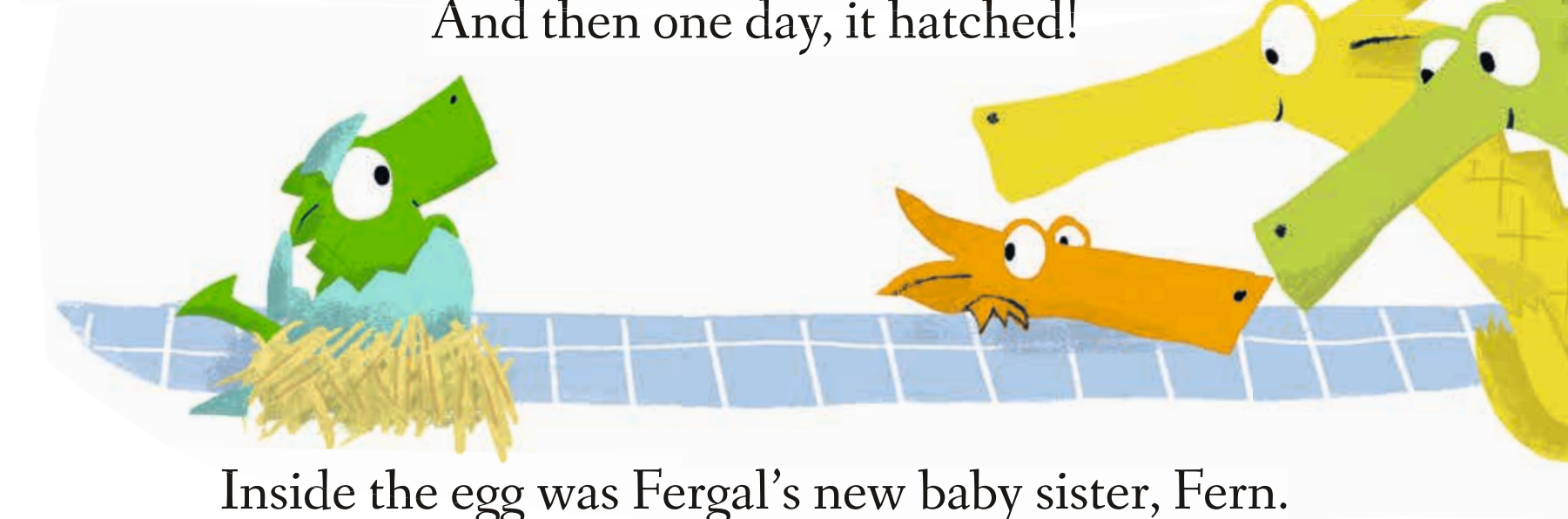
Or he was, until
